## What is Kazin 60+?

Kazin 60+ will be a fun, creative and learning outcomes driven project, based on the theatre world. In a group setting, two theatre practitioners and actors will lead two groups towards achieving new theatrical experiences. Guest tutors will also be invited to some of the sessions with the intention of sharing their expertise in the Arts and Performance field. This project will be fun - full of theatre games, improvisations, movement, singing, reading and learning of possible small scenes and texts. This creative space will be shared and enjoyed with like-minded persons from different walks of life, allowing the opportunity to develop new found friendships.

From one session to another the new group of actors will gain experience as well as confidence, which can help with being on stage, delivering a speech but also in one's daily life.

As a bonus, research in well-being shows that remaining creative, learning new skills and taking on new challenges in the later years is an all round win-win situation, and has proven to be beneficial on a physical and psychological level.

## Who are we looking for?

We are looking for 15–20 individuals to make up a group for Kazin 60+, these include:

- Persons who enjoy being in a group aged 60+.
- Persons who enjoy a laugh.
- Persons who are not scared to try things for the first time.
- Persons who are willing to work as part of a team.
- Persons who feel comfortable moving through predefined/choreographed but also free movement.
- Persons who could possibly sing or play an instrument, but not necessary.

### 16th October - 22nd October

production week including performances at the weekend

### after the performance

meetings every fortnight until mid December
