We need you for approximately **10 hours** throughout the rehearsal period in the mornings and afternoons until the <u>17 March</u>, and for approximately **30 hours** throughout production week between <u>20 and 26 March</u>, mostly mornings and afternoons, with the exception of the <u>25 March</u> where you'll be required in the late afternoon/evening.

STAGE MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP

Broadening your knowledge on the subject of stage management at this role's core, so we've included a Stage Management Workshop to further train you in the field, before you start putting your knowledge to practice during the festival.







Duties

- Be available and present for production week (Monday 20th March - Friday 24th March) and production weekend (Saturday 25th March) and Sunday 26th March)
- Assist the designated Director to list any changes made to the script, cues and staging during rehearsals throughout production week;
- Assist in sorting, storing and organising props on stage and off stage before, during and after the performances, under the instructions of the Stage Manager;
- Assist the Director and the Stage Manager on logistical matters relating to the stage, set and props for the Production.
